PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This ECC covers the operation of a Water Supply System - Level III (Distribution System only) Project, consisting of one (1) pumping station equipped with deepwell, pump house, chlorinator, control box, discharge line assembly, distribution pipeline, and basic utilities; all confined within a lot area of 1,470 square meters designated as Lot No. 32250-A, PLS. 1116.

II. GENERAL CONDITIONS

 The proponent shall undertake an effective and sustained Information, Education and Communication (IEC) Campaign to explain publicly its mitigating measures as well as the conditions of this ECC. It shall open



opportunities to educate the public especially the affected community, interested academic institutions and other parties on the environment and human health safety features of the project including mitigating measures on the effects of climate change;

- An ECC Billboard (3' X 5') shall be installed at a strategic location at the project site containing this message: "NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC, THIS [Project Name] of [Project Proponent] has been issued an Environmental Compliance Certificate [ECC Ref. No.] by the DENR-Environmental Management Bureau Region 1 on [Date of Issuance];"
- Parties and communities affected by the negative impacts of the project shall be appropriately compensated;
- The Proponent shall notify the EMB RO1, and submit an abandonment mitigating plan for approval at least three (3) months prior to project abandonment;
- 5. The Proponent shall allow DENR-EMB Personnel with valid identification card and travel/mission order to conduct inspection/monitoring in the entire premises even without prior notice to monitor compliance with ECC conditions and other environmental laws, and implementation of approved EMP. Further, on-the-spot monitoring and inspection may be initiated by the DENR any time in coordination with concerned parties;

III. RESTRICTIONS

- 6. No activities shall be undertaken other than what were stipulated in the IEEC. Any expansion of the project beyond the project description or any change in the activity or transfer of location shall be the subject of a new Environmental Impact Assessment; and
- 7. Transfer of ownership of this project shall carry the same conditions and restrictions and the transferor (with concurrence/confirmation letter from the transferee) shall be required to notify the EMB RO1 within fifteen (15) days from the transfer of ownership to allow the necessary changes brought about by such transfer.

DENR-Regional Office/PENRO/CENRO

- 6. The proponent shall secure tree cutting permit (if applicable).
- The proponent shall comply with the provisions set forth in the PAMB Clearance (if applicable);
- The proponent shall coordinate with Biodiversity Management Bureau (BMB) for the preparation and implementation of the Biodiversity and Monitoring Systems pursuant to Technical Bulletin Nos. 2016-05 and 2019-04 (if applicable)

- 9. The proponent shall comply with the Labor Code of the Philippines
